ABOUT THE POSITION

The ideal candidate will have a practical mindset; be detail-oriented and self-motivated to ensure the Club is well maintained and all systems are operating to their full potential.

Terminal City Club has 11 meeting spaces, 2 ballrooms, 2 restaurants, 1 pub, 1 wine & cocktail lounge, 6 billiards tables, 3 squash courts, a four-lane 25-meter swimming pool, a state-of-the-art fitness centre and licensed patios on four levels of the club with sweeping views of the North Shore mountains. We work with members and non-members to provide a tradition of service on which the Club was founded.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform a highly diversified number of duties related to maintenance; install, troubleshoot, repair and maintain facility equipment and general building maintenance according to safety standards, predictive and productive maintenance systems
- Conduct daily walk-throughs of the Club's critical maintenance areas and track activities as directed
- Work closely with the Lead Technician, Assistant Building Engineer and Chief Engineer as required

- Minimum 2 years' maintenance experience in a commercial or residential multi-functional building preferred
- 4th Class power engineer
- Hands-on practical knowledge of most common mechanical building equipment, food service equipment and general building maintenance
- Familiar with most common plumbing, electrical, refrigeration and kitchen production equipment
- Demonstrated track record of safe handling and usage of most power tools
- Able to work efficiently and calmly in a fast paced environment with frequently changing priorities
- Works well in a team environment as well as independently
- Effective communicator with good interpersonal and listening skills
- Understand and apply Health & Safety regulations, laws and protocols at all times

WORKING CONDITIONS & PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to lift and unpack boxes up to 20lbs
- Work with engineers and technicians supporting a large commercial building
- Work under tight deadlines and often high pressure emergencies due to appliance/equipment/parts failure
- Regular shifting of priorities due to the nature of commercial building maintenance
- Morning, Afternoon, and Evening shift work, including weekends
