What is the cost of renting a locker?

LIQUOR LOCKER \$315 annual rental billed on December 31
WINE LOCKER* (12-bottle) \$555 annual rental billed on September 30
WINE LOCKER* (24-bottle) \$1,032 annual rental billed on September 30

*Wine lockers are temperature-controlled at 13° C.

Can I cancel my locker at any time?

Yes; a prorated refund of the annual rental will be made once the key to the locker has been returned. You may take any unopened spirit bottles home, however, previously opened spirit bottles may not be removed from the Club.

What if I lose my locker key?

Please let a staff member know and we can have a new key cut for you. This may take up to three business days to complete. A \$25 replacement fee will be billed to your account.

How do I order wine or liquor for my locker?

How are wine and spirit bottles priced at the Club?

Pricing is calculated using the following formula:

(BCL cost + tax) + corkage* + service charge + liquor tax + GST

Sample Pricing:

Ketel One Vodka
 \$36.49 at BC Liquor Store
 + tax & deposit
 = **\$42.08** **replacement cost**
 + \$25.00 corkage for bottles under \$50
 = **\$67.08** **subtotal**
 = **\$68.00**
 + \$13.60 service charge
 + \$6.80 liquor tax
 + \$4.08 GST
 = **\$92.48**

stocking your locker

What is the value of maintaining a Liquor or Wine Locker vs. ordering from the bar?

Having a Liquor or Wine Locker is an exclusive Club experience that isn't available at restaurants or hotels. Members who entertain often enjoy treating their close friends, important clients, and valued colleagues to a drink from their personal collection.

Purchasing bottles of spirits or wine is often more cost-effective than ordering the equivalent amount from the bar by the ounce or glass.

Can I bring a bottle of wine from home in to store in my locker?

Yes; you may bring your own bottle of wine to the Club to consume during your dining experience or store in your Wine Locker. The wine must be unopened and commercially produced. Please note there is a \$45 corkage fee per bottle; members who maintain a wine locker will only be billed \$25 per bottle.

Can I bring a bottle of spirits or beer from home to store in my locker?

No; spirits (hard liquor) and beer must be purchased through the Club.

Can I keep spirits in my Wine Locker and wine in my Liquor Locker?

You may keep wine in your Liquor Locker but because they are not temperature-controlled it is not recommended for long-term wine storage.

Because our Wine Lockers only permit bottles to be stored on their sides, you may not keep open bottles of wine or spirits in them.

I have too many wine bottles to fit into my locker. Is there another space I can store them?

Yes; you may keep an extra 12 bottles in our cellar. If you need access to those extra bottles, simply ask a team member for assistance.

Where can I find glassware or a corkscrew to open my bottle?

The Members' Lounge is fully stocked. Our team can provide you with corkscrews, glassware, ice buckets, decanters, etc. If you prefer, they will also be able to open and pour your wine for you and your guests.

Can I take my unfinished bottle of wine home with me?

Yes, provided that one of the service staff re-seals the wine bottle for you before you leave. If you are departing in a car, you must ensure it is not readily accessible to anyone in the vehicle while driving. (Store it behind the seat or in the trunk.)

Where am I able to enjoy my bottle of wine or spirits from my locker?

You may enjoy the contents of your Wine or Liquor locker in the Grill, the Members' Lounge and Cuvée. **Bottles are not permitted in private function rooms (banquet spaces) unless a steward is hired for the event.** In Club Rooms, only bottles of wine are permitted.

What happens if I want a cocktail made with the liquor in my locker?

You may ask a bartender to make a cocktail with the spirits in your locker. A cocktail prep charge of \$3.50 will apply plus any additional ingredients used from the bar. For example, for a margarita, we would use your tequila and add the 0.5 oz charge for the orange liqueur, plus the cocktail prep charge.
