Growing up Outdoors

Do you remember how much of your childhood was spent outside, away from watchful adults—wandering, climbing, taking risks, and figuring things out for yourself?

Many of us grew up with freedoms that seem almost unimaginable for children today. Yet we often struggle to give younger generations the same independence we once took for granted.

Join UBC developmental psychologist **Dr. Mariana Brussoni** for a lively conversation about what has changed in childhood—and in us. Why are we more fearful of risk? What do children lose when adults constantly intervene? And how can we distinguish between genuine danger and the kinds of risks children need to grow?

Dr. Mariana Brussoni is the Director of the Human Early Learning Partnership, and a Professor in the Department of Pediatrics and the School of Population and Public Health at the University of British Columbia (UBC). She is a developmental psychologist and is an investigator with the British Columbia Children’s Hospital Research Institute and the British Columbia Injury Research & Prevention Unit.

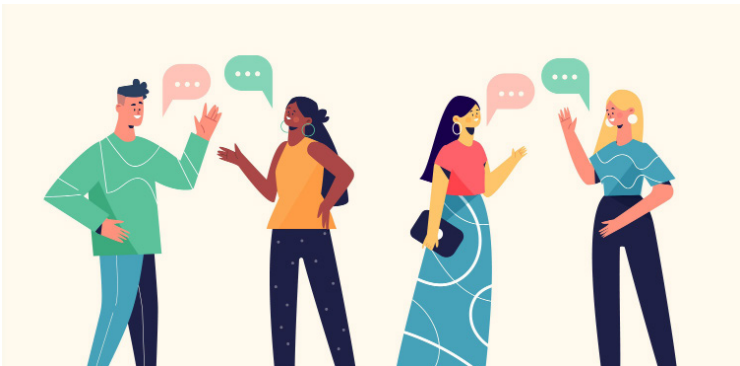

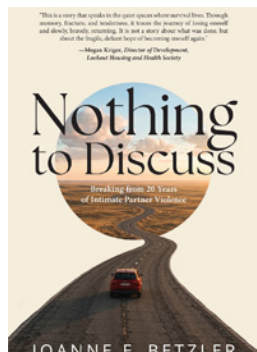

Member of the Month

JENNIFER MUENCH

After completing a Bachelor of Science from the University of Waterloo, Jennifer Muench was awarded a scholarship to complete a PHD in biophysics at the University of Pennsylvania. She turned it down.

"I learned through co-op job placements that I didn't like working in the lab," she recalls. "I phoned my mom and told her I wasn't going. I thought she would be upset, but instead she said: 'Oh thank goodness, dear, that's not the best fit for your personality.'"

Jennifer's father was an administrator of a hospital in Ontario. He thought Jennifer should complete an MBA at McMaster University, a school with an established and highly regarded co-op program. Dad thought this was important as Jennifer had no business experience. By the time she finished her degree, each one of the companies she worked with through the program wanted to bring her on full-time. One of those companies was a boutique hedge fund in Toronto.

"I didn't take that offer. They were rather shocked by my decision. It was a firm with 10 men. They called my 'Dolly.' When they asked me why I didn't accept their offer, I told them my name was Jennifer and I had choices."

The offer she did accept was with the Bank of Montreal where she worked for more than 20 years. She began in 1998 as a financial analyst, then soon moved into the corporation's management

stream. In 2008, she was promoted to vice-president for retail banking in Greater Vancouver. In 2013, she moved into BMO Private Banking (now BMO Private Wealth) where she stayed until 2020 as regional president for British Columbia. ① Escala Humana Chenin Blanc 'Livverá' 2025 Uco Valley, Argentina \$87

Planted in 1980, these chenin blanc vines grow in the meagre clay/sandy soils of the elite Uco Valley at 1,150 metres elevation. Fermenting in small concrete eggs allows chenin's melon fruit, exotic citrus, beeswax and floral perfume to seduce the senses. Escala Humana was started by an experienced husband-and-wife team who relished the 'human scale' of the small vineyards that celebrate Argentina's wine history. Ideal with a plump and juicy grilled pork chop.

② Ricca Terra Juicy June 2024 Riverland, Australia \$52

Made by a former bronco buster (for real!), Juicy June is cheerful, crushable red from South Australia, made from two Italian grapes, nero d'avola and negroamaro. Aussies are currently obsessed with Italian varieties and are tucking them into all corners of the vast continent. Sweet-fruited and fresh, Juicy June is light yet shapely, intense and bouncy in the mouth. Perfect rib or chicken wing wine, or you could track down a proper Aussie meat pie to pair.

③ Domaine du Dragon Grande Cuvée Rosé 2025 Côte de Provence, France \$66

Breathing juicy red berries rather than fire, this Dragon rosé is a selection of the finest plots of grenache, cinsault, syrah and mourvèdre, family-farmed since 1850. Based in the excellently named town of Draguignan, this rosé combines precision, power, wild strawberry and peachy fruit, heavily dusted with limestone minerals. Summer is not over, and this wine should accompany your finest grilled sockeye salmon served with a classic bistro salad.

④ Olivier Rivière Plaisir Simple 2024 Bordeaux, France \$70

Frenchman Olivier Rivière has finally returned to France after over 15 years in Spain. Raised in the Cognac region, he has now chosen the Right Bank region of Bourg for his latest project. His challenge is breathing fresh life back into the soils, the vineyards, and the winemaking of the Côtes de Bourg, a secret-value region on the Right Bank of Bordeaux. Olivier founded his organic project back in 2022, working with a geologist to delineate his micro-plots along the natural shifts in subsoils and strata. Merlot forms the heart of this quotidian red, named 'plaisir simple' (simple pleasure) and meant for weeknight savouring with simple, tasty crockpot dinner.

⑤ Domaine Baudry Chinon Les Granges 2023 Loire Valley, France \$85

Well-tempered cabernet franc from an undisputed master in the tiny appellation of Chinon, this is a delicious introduction to the Baudry style. Les Granges comes from 30- to 40-year-old vines growing along the banks of the Loire River in sandy, gravelly alluvial soils... the kind of terroir that shapes easy, light and highly approachable wines. Organically farmed since 2000, this pure, honest, giving and reassuring red has no oak at all; just a ravishing cascade of cassis fruit, ripe dark cherries, garden herbs and firm but plush tannins. Pair with a picnic blanket and dinner of a fresh baguette, rustic pâté, Dijon, cornichons, and a simple salad. Ooh la la, c'est parfait!

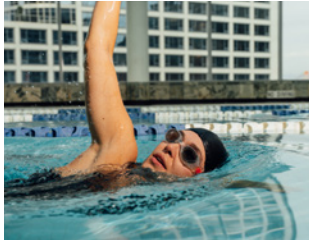
